The [SMCI](#) is a tool, which ranks European and North American cities based on a set of 5 index measures. Currently it leverages current census data, policies, and conditions to allow cities and operators to anticipate prosperous opportunities and upcoming challenges.

Since 2015 the shared mobility landscape has changed significantly: ride-hailing has gained popularity, e-scooter share programs are taking off and MaaS is entering the space. This is why the SMCI 2018 edition will undergo a major update: the evaluation criteria will be redefined before the data for 20 North American cities is collected and then benchmarked.

- Prepare proposal for additional benchmark criteria based on your studies and SMCI's overall objective
- Collaborate with 2nd Analyst on criteria update and build a joint proposal that is presented to Project Manager
- Once new criteria are signed off, gather data for 10 North American cities
- Evaluate cities against benchmark criteria and calculate final scores for each city
- Write individual city report & review overall report and design copy

Requirements and Conditions:

- Must be eligible to work in Canada
- Must be able to work independently as well as in small team
- Ability to collect data and establish facts and identify trends and variances
- Ability to integrate information from a variety of sources with varied levels of complexity
- Ability to review and interpret and evaluate statistical information
- Strong analytical skills and attention to detail
- Strong English writing skills
